FC-CONFLIST(1)

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NAME

fc-conflist - list the configuration files processed by Fontconfig

SYNOPSIS

fc-conflist [-Vh]

[--version] [--help]

DESCRIPTION

fc-conflist prints an annotated list of all the configuration files processed by Fontconfig.

The output is a '-' or '+' depending on whether the file is ignored or processed, a space, the file's path, a colon and space, and the description from the file or 'No description' if none is present.

The order of files looks like how fontconfig actually processes them except one contains <include> element. In that case, it will be shown after processing all the sub directories where is targeted by <include>.

OPTIONS

This program follows the usual GNU command line syntax, with long options starting with two dashes ('-'). A summary of options is included below.

-V --version

Show version of the program and exit.

-h --help

Show summary of options.

RETURN CODES

fc-conflist returns error code 0 for successful parsing, or 1 if any errors occurred or if

at least one font face could not be opened.
