LSATTR(1) General Commands Manual LSATTR(1)

NAME

lsattr - list ext2/ext3/ext4 file attributes

SYNOPSIS

lsattr [-RVadlpv] [files...]

DESCRIPTION

lsattr lists the file attributes on an ext2/ext3/ext4 file system. See chattr(1) for a description of the attributes and what they mean.

OPTIONS

- R Recursively list attributes of directories and their contents.
- V Display the program version.
- a List all files in directories, including files that start with `.`.
- d List directories like other files, rather than listing their contents.
- l Print the options using long names instead of single character abbreviations.
- p List the file's project number.
- v List the file's version/generation number.
