DESCRIPTION

`memcmp()` determines whether the first `n` bytes of the memory areas pointed to by `m1` and `m2` are equal.

RETURN VALUE

`memeq()` returns true if and only if the first `n` bytes of the memory areas pointed to by `m1` and `m2` are equal.
