Description

"Starring" a package means that you have some interest in it. It's

a vaguely positive way to show that you care.

It's a boolean thing. Starring repeatedly has no additional effect.

There's also these extra commands to help you manage your favorite packages:

Unstar

You can also "unstar" a package using `npm unstar`

"Unstarring" is the same thing, but in reverse.

Listing stars

You can see all your starred packages using `npm stars`
