



Linux Ubuntu 26.04 Manual Pages on command 'pip-list.1'

\$ man pip-list.1

PIP3-LIST(1) pip PIP3-LIST(1)

NAME

pip3-list - description of pip3 list command

DESCRIPTION

List installed packages, including editables.

Packages are listed in a case-insensitive sorted order.

USAGE

python -m pip list [options]

OPTIONS

-o, --outdated

List outdated packages

(environment variable: PIP_OUTDATED)

-u, --uptodate

List uptodate packages

(environment variable: PIP_UPTODATE)

-e, --editable

List editable projects.

(environment variable: PIP_EDITABLE)

-l, --local

If in a virtualenv that has global access, do not list globally-installed packages.

(environment variable: PIP_LOCAL)

--user Only output packages installed in user-site.

(environment variable: PIP_USER)

`--path <path>`

Restrict to the specified installation path for listing packages (can be used multiple times).

(environment variable: PIP_PATH)

`--pre` Include pre-release and development versions. By default, pip only finds stable versions.

(environment variable: PIP_PRE)

`--format <list_format>`

Select the output format among: columns (default), freeze, or json. The 'freeze' format cannot be used with the `--outdated` option.

(environment variable: PIP_FORMAT)

`--not-required`

List packages that are not dependencies of installed packages.

(environment variable: PIP_NOT_REQUIRED)

`--exclude-editable`

Exclude editable package from output.

(environment variable: PIP_EXCLUDE_EDITABLE)

`--include-editable`

Include editable package in output.

(environment variable: PIP_INCLUDE_EDITABLE)

`--exclude <package>`

Exclude specified package from the output

(environment variable: PIP_EXCLUDE)
