PTARDIFF(1)

NAME

ptardiff - program that diffs an extracted archive against an unextracted one

DESCRIPTION

ptardiff is a small program that diffs an extracted archive against an unextracted one, using the perl module Archive::Tar.

This effectively lets you view changes made to an archives contents.

Provide the program with an ARCHIVE_FILE and it will look up all the files with in the archive, scan the current working directory for a file with the name and diff it against the contents of the archive.

SYNOPSIS

ptardiff ARCHIVE_FILE

ptardiff -h

```
$ tar -xzf Acme-Buffy-1.3.tar.gz
```

```
$ vi Acme-Buffy-1.3/README
```

```
$ ptardiff Acme-Buffy-1.3.tar.gz > README.patch
```
