ECHO(1) General Commands Manual ECHO(1)

NAME

echo - Display a line of text

SYNOPSIS

echo [-n] [-e] [-E] [-h|--help] [-V|--version] [STRING]

DESCRIPTION

Display a line of text

OPTIONS

- n do not output the trailing newline
- e enable interpretation of backslash escapes
- E disable interpretation of backslash escapes (default)
- h, --help
 Print help
- V, --version
 Print version

[STRING]

EXTRA

Echo the STRING(s) to standard output.

If -e is in effect, the following sequences are recognized:

- \ backslash - \a alert (BEL) - \b backspace - \c produce no further output - \e escape -
- \f form feed - \n new line - \r carriage return - \t horizontal tab - \v vertical tab -
- \ONNN byte with octal value NNN (1 to 3 digits) - \xHH byte with hexadecimal value HH (1 to 2 digits)
