SENSIBLE-TERMINAL(1) General Commands Manual SENSIBLE-TERMINAL(1)

NAME

sensible-terminal - sensible terminal emulator

SYNOPSIS

sensible-terminal [-Ttitle][--wait][--ecmd...]

DESCRIPTION

sensible-terminal-emulator makes sensible decisions on which terminal emulator to call.

Programs in Debian can use this script as their default terminal emulator or emulate their behavior. `TERMINAL_EMULATOR` environment variable could be set, and will be used if set.

Any string acceptable as a `command_string` operand to the `sh -c` command shall be valid.

STANDARD

Documentation of behavior of sensible-utils under a debian system is available under sections 11.4-11.8 of debian-policy usually installed under `/usr/share/doc/debian-policy` (you might need to install `debian-policy`)

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
