UUID_COPY(3)

NAME

uuid_copy - copy a UUID value

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <uuid.h>
```

```
void uuid_copy(uuid_t dst, const uuid_t src);
```

DESCRIPTION

The `uuid_copy()` function copies the UUID variable `src` to `dst`.

RETURN VALUE

The copied UUID is returned in the location pointed to by `dst`.
