NAME

uuid_is_null - compare the value of the UUID to the NULL value

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <uuid.h>
```

```
int uuid_is_null(const uuid_t uu);
```

DESCRIPTION

The `uuid_is_null()` function compares the value of the supplied UUID variable `uu` to the NULL value. If the value is equal to the NULL UUID, 1 is returned, otherwise 0 is returned.
