wcsrchr - search a wide character in a wide-character string

LIBRARY

Standard C library (libc, -lc)

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <wchar.h>
```

```
wchar_t *wcsrchr(const wchar_t *wcs, wchar_t wc);
```

DESCRIPTION

The `wcsrchr()` function is the wide-character equivalent of the `strchr(3)` function. It searches the last occurrence of `wc` in the wide-character string pointed to by `wcs`.

RETURN VALUE

The `wcsrchr()` function returns a pointer to the last occurrence of `wc` in the wide-character string pointed to by `wcs`, or `NULL` if `wc` does not occur in the string.
