

**NAME**

ctanh, ctanhf, ctanhl – complex hyperbolic tangent

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <complex.h>
```

```
double complex ctanh(double complex z);
```

```
float complex ctanhf(float complex z);
```

```
long double complex ctanhl(long double complex z);
```

Link with `-lm`.

**DESCRIPTION**

These functions calculate the complex hyperbolic tangent of  $z$ .

The complex hyperbolic tangent function is defined mathematically as:

$$\operatorname{ctanh}(z) = \operatorname{csinh}(z) / \operatorname{ccosh}(z)$$

**VERSIONS**

These functions first appeared in glibc in version 2.1.
