`docker-volume-ls` - List volumes

SYNOPSIS

`docker volume ls [OPTIONS]`

DESCRIPTION

Lists all the volumes Docker manages. You can filter using the `-f` or `--filter` flag. The filtering format is a `key=value` pair. To specify more than one filter, pass multiple flags (for example, `--filter "foo=bar" --filter "bif=baz"`)

The currently supported filters are:

- `dangling` (boolean - `true` or `false`, 1 or 0)
- `driver` (a volume driver's name)
- `label` (`label=<key>` or `label=<key>=<value>`)
- `name` (a volume's name)

OPTIONS

`-f, --filter=` Provide filter values (e.g. `'dangling=true'`)

`--format=""` Pretty-print volumes using a Go template

`-h, --help[=false]` help for `ls`

`-q, --quiet[=false]` Only display volume names
