

NAME

grub-editenv – edit GRUB environment block

SYNOPSIS

grub-editenv [*OPTION...*] *FILENAME COMMAND*

DESCRIPTION

Tool to edit environment block.

Commands:

create Create a blank environment block file.

list List the current variables.

set [*NAME=VALUE ...*]

Set variables.

unset [*NAME ...*]

Delete variables.

Options:

-?, --help

give this help list

--usage

give a short usage message

-v, --verbose

print verbose messages.

-V, --version

print program version

If *FILENAME* is '-', the default value */boot/grub/grubenv* is used.

There is no 'delete' command; if you want to delete the whole environment block, use 'rm */boot/grub/grubenv*'.
