ip maddress [add | del] MULTIADDR dev NAME

ip maddress show [dev NAME]

DESCRIPTION

maddress objects are multicast addresses.

$ip\ maddress\ show\ \hbox{--list multicast addresses}$

dev NAME (default)

the device name.

ip maddress add - add a multicast address

ip maddress delete - delete a multicast address

These commands attach/detach a static link-layer multicast address to listen on the interface. Note that it is impossible to join protocol multicast groups statically. This command only manages link-layer addresses.

address LLADDRESS (default)

the link-layer multicast address.

dev NAME

the device to join/leave this multicast address.
