### **NAME**

ntfsinfo - dump a file's attributes

## **SYNOPSIS**

**ntfsinfo** [options] device

## **DESCRIPTION**

**ntfsinfo** will dump the attributes of inode *inode-number* or the file path-filename and/or information about the mft (-m option). Run ntfsinfo without arguments for a full list of options.

### **OPTIONS**

Below is a summary of all the options that **ntfsinfo** accepts. Nearly all options have two equivalent names. The short name is preceded by - and the long name is preceded by -. Any single letter options, that don't take an argument, can be combined into a single command, e.g.  $-\mathbf{f}\mathbf{v}$  is equivalent to  $-\mathbf{f} - \mathbf{v}$ . Long named options can be abbreviated to any unique prefix of their name.

### -F, --file FILE

Show information about this file

### -f, --force

This will override some sensible defaults, such as not overwriting an existing file. Use this option with caution.

## -h, --help

Show a list of options with a brief description of each one.

## -i, --inode NUM

Show information about this inode.

## -m, --mft

Show information about the volume.

# -q, --quiet

Produce less output.

## -t, --notime

Do not display timestamps in the output.

## -v, --verbose

Increase the amount of output that **ntfsinfo** prints.

### -V, --version

Show the version number, copyright and license.
