## **NAME**

pam\_getenv - get environment variables from /etc/environment

## **SYNOPSIS**

pam\_getenv [-l] [-s] env\_var

## **DESCRIPTION**

This tool will print out the value of *env\_var* from */etc/environment*. It will attempt to expand environment variable references in the definition of *env\_var* but will fail if PAM items are expanded.

The **-l** option indicates the script should return an environment variable related to default locale information.

The -s option indicates that the script should return an system default environment variable.

Currently neither the **-l** or **-s** options do anything. They are included because future versions of Debian may have a separate repository for the initial environment used by init scripts and for system locale information. These options will allow this script to be a stable interface even in that environment.
