

NAME

ssh-sk-helper — OpenSSH helper for FIDO authenticator support

SYNOPSIS

ssh-sk-helper [**-v**]

DESCRIPTION

ssh-sk-helper is used by `ssh-agent(1)` to access keys provided by a FIDO authenticator.

ssh-sk-helper is not intended to be invoked by the user, but from `ssh-agent(1)`.

A single option is supported:

-v Verbose mode. Causes **ssh-sk-helper** to print debugging messages about its progress. This is helpful in debugging problems. Multiple **-v** options increase the verbosity. The maximum is 3.

Note that `ssh-agent(1)` will automatically pass the **-v** flag to **ssh-sk-helper** when it has itself been placed in debug mode.
