

**NAME**

systemd-modules-load.service, systemd-modules-load – Load kernel modules at boot

**SYNOPSIS**

systemd–modules–load.service

/lib/systemd/systemd–modules–load

**DESCRIPTION**

systemd–modules–load.service is an early boot service that loads kernel modules based on static configuration.

See **modules-load.d(5)** for information about the configuration of this service.

**KERNEL COMMAND LINE**

systemd–modules–load.service understands the following kernel command line parameters:

*modules\_load=*, *rd.modules\_load=*

Takes a comma-separated list of kernel modules to statically load during early boot. The option prefixed with "rd." is read by the initial RAM disk only.
